



Frederico Perego Costa, MD – Chair

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Dr Frederico Perego Costa is a medical oncologist on the faculty of the Centro de Oncologia of the Hospital Sírio-Libanês. Dr Costa received his medical degree from the Escola Paulista de Medicina in São Paulo, Brazil, and subsequently completed a residency in internal medicine at the Hospital das Clínicas da Universidade de São Paulo Escola de Medicina. This was followed by a fellowship in hematology and oncology at the Memorial Sloan-Kettering Cancer Center in New York, NY. Dr Costa has held various administrative posts, most recently, coordinator of the Grupo dos Tumores Neuroendócrinos and founder and medical director of the Pesquisa Clínica do Instituto Brasileiro de Pesquisa em

Câncer. His research activities include developing and conducting clinical trials in gastrointestinal tumors and liver metastasis, and he has has a special interest in gastrointestinal neuroendocrine tumors. His research has been widely published and presented at numerous medical conferences.



Jaume Capdevila, MD

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Dr Jaume Capdevila has served since 2006 as deputy medical oncologist at Vall d’Hebron University Hospital and Vall d’Hebron Institute of Oncology (VHIO) in Barcelona, Spain. Dr Capdevila obtained his medical degree at the University of Lleida, in Catalonia. He completed a fellowship in the Department of Biochemistry and Molecular Biology at the University of Lleida from 2000-2001, and from 2002-2006, he pursued a specialization in medical oncology at the Hospital de la Santa Creu i Sant Pau at the Universitat Autònoma de Barcelona.

Dr Capdevila’s research focuses on the treatment of patients with gastrointestinal cancer and endocrine tumors, as well as on early drug development. He has authored and co-authored more than 30 articles published in peer-reviewed journals and also several book chapters. He is an active member of several oncology societies (American Society of Clinical Oncology [ASCO], Sociedad Española de Oncología Médica [SEOM], Grupo Español de Tumores Neuroendócrinos [GETNE], and European Neuroendocrine Tumor Society [ENETS]) and actively participates in national and international clinical trials. In addition, he serves as an advisory board member for ENETS and as secretary and treasurer of GETNE.
